There is now an Early Help Strategy in place and all stakeholders will contribute so that it will be a multi-agency Early Help Strategy. This is currently being completed by the Partnership & Prevention Subgroup. It was agreed that the Early Help Forum needed to be reinvigorated and to restart. They are currently being held on a fortnight basis. OFSTED raised this as good practice

The Purpose of the Early Help Forum:

- To have collaborative conversations between Agencies to ensure that families are getting the ***right help at the right time from the right service.***
- Regular multi-agency group supervision on cases using an evidence based model of practice (Signs of Safety and a Restorative Approach). This is to help Agencies who might be offering Early Help to families but struggling for a variety of reasons.

- Ensures contributions from all participants, and effectively identifies the range of risks, protective factors and unknowns which underpin a multi-agency discussion about level of risk and thresholds in respect of any families that you may be concerned about.
- Restorative approach for appropriate evidence based escalations to Stronger Families (level 3) or Children Social Care (Level 4).
- Information, Advice and Guidance to partners who are Lead Practitioners offering early help to families if they remain the lead to explore other ways of engaging families where there is disguised compliance, non-engagement or neglect.
- Disputes on Step Downs from Children Social Care to Partners can be resolved offering solutions/alternatives.
